Producer Price Inflation decreased to 15.19% in December 2011

The Producer Price Index

The Producer Price Index (PPI) measures the average change over time in the prices received by domestic producers for the production of their goods and services. The PPI for Ghana reports the price indices with reference to September 2006, the base period. This release shows the producer price changes since September 2006, as well as the annual (year-on-year) and monthly inflation rates, for all industry and three major sub-sectors of industry (Mining and Quarrying, Manufacturing, and Utilities) for the last twelve months. The figures for the month of December 2011 are provisional, and are subject to revision in the release when additional data would be available. All other indicators are final.

December 2011 Producer Inflation

The producer price index increased 15.19 percent between December 2010 and December 2011(year-on-year), representing a decrease in producer inflation of 2.76 percentage points relative to the rate in November 2011 (17.94%). The month-on-month change in producer prices was -0.17 percent, after recording an increase (2.48%) in November 2011 (Table 1).

The producer price index averaged 242.92 in 2011 compared to 204.68 in 2010. In December 2011, the producer price inflation in the mining and quarrying sector dropped by 18.14 percentage points over the November 2011 rate of 36.36%, to record 18.23 percent. Manufacturing, which constitutes more than two-thirds of total industry, decreased marginally to 17.23 percent, from a rate of 17.52 percent in November 2011. The utilities sector increased slightly by 1.36 percentage points from the November 2011 rate (7.71%) to record 9.07 percent in December, 2011 (Table 2)

Trends

During the 12-month period (December 2010 to December 2011), the all industry inflation rate rose steadily from December 2010 (17.79%) peaking in April 2011 (24.29%). It declined between May and June, and resumed the increase until September 2011 (19.59 %). The rate declined in October 2011, increased slightly in November 2011, recording a

rate of 17.28% percent, but declined in December 2011 to record 15.19%.

Manufacturing Sector

During the month of December 2011, eight out of the sixteen major groups in the manufacturing sector recorded inflation rates higher than the sector average of 17.23 percent (Fig. 2). Manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c recorded the highest inflation rate (38.05%) whilst manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers recorded the lowest rate (2.33%)

Petroleum Price Index


Over the last two years, inflation in the petroleum industry subgroup recorded four major significant changes in December 2009, April 2010, June 2010, and January 2011. The price increase in January 2011 resulted in a sharp rise in inflation for this subgroup in January 2011 (23.39 %), but remained stable since then, recording 25.82 percent in December 2011 (Fig 3).


Highlights


The year-on-year producer inflation for all industry in December 2011 is 15.19%; the monthly rate is -0.17 percent.

Mining and quarrying recorded the highest year-onyear rate of 18.23%, followed by manufacturing (17.23%). Utilities recorded the lowest rate of 9.07%.

The monthly change rate indicated that, manufacturing recorded the highest monthly change of 1.53%, followed by utilities (1.41%). Mining and quarrying recorded a negative monthly change rate of 8.37%.




