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Producer Price Inflation Drop to 12.15% in June 2011

The Producer Price Index

The Producer Price Index (PPI) measures the average change over time in the prices received by domestic producers for the production of their goods and services. The PPI for Ghana reports the price indices with reference to September 2006, the base period. This release shows the producer price changes since September 2006, as well as the annual (year-on-year) and monthly inflation rates, for all industry and three major sub-sectors of industry (Mining and Quarrying, Manufacturing, and Utilities) for the last twelve months. The data for the month of June 2011 are provisional, and are subject to revision in the following month. All other data are final.

June 2011 Producer Inflation

The producer price index increased 12.15 percent between June 2010 and June 2011 (year-on-year), representing a drop in producer inflation of 11.05 percentage points relative to the rate in May 2011 (23.20%). The month-on-month producer prices rose 0.47 percent, after increasing 0.25 percent in the May 2011 (Table 1).

Inflation in mining and quarrying was 30.24 percent, representing a decline in the rate for May 2011 (32.60%) by 2.36 percentage points. Manufacturing which constitutes more than two-thirds of total industry increased slightly to 12.10 percent, from 11.84 percent in May, 2011. The lowest year-on-year price change of 0.27 was recorded in the Utilities sector, and this has contributed, to some extent, to the drop in producer inflation for the month of June 2011.

Trends

The June 2011 inflation rate was 12.15, dropping by 11.05 percentage points compared to the May rate of 23.20%, the lowest rate in the 12-month period.

During the 12-month period (June 2010 to June 2011), the all industry recorded the highest producer inflation rate in April 2011. From June 2010, the rate was quite stable, until November

2010 when it declined. Thereafter, the rate had been rising steadily until May 2011. The June 2011 producer inflation rate recorded a sharp decline which is attributed to the drop in the rate for the utility sector. For the past twelve months, the utility sector persistently recorded the highest producer inflation of about 70% (June 2010 to May 2011), among the sectors in industry (Fig. 1).

Manufacturing Sector

Nine out of the sixteen major groups in the manufacturing sector recorded inflation rates higher than the manufacturing sector average of 12.10 percent. Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers, and semi-trailers recorded the highest inflation rate (28.87%), whilst manufacture of fabricated metal recorded a negative change in the rate by 2.33 percent (Fig. 2).

Petroleum Price Index

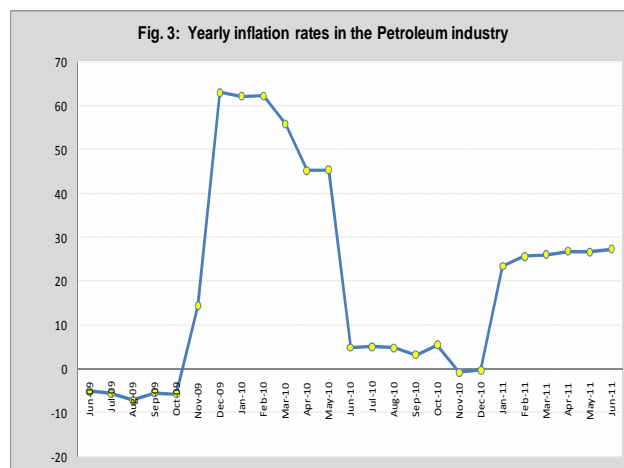
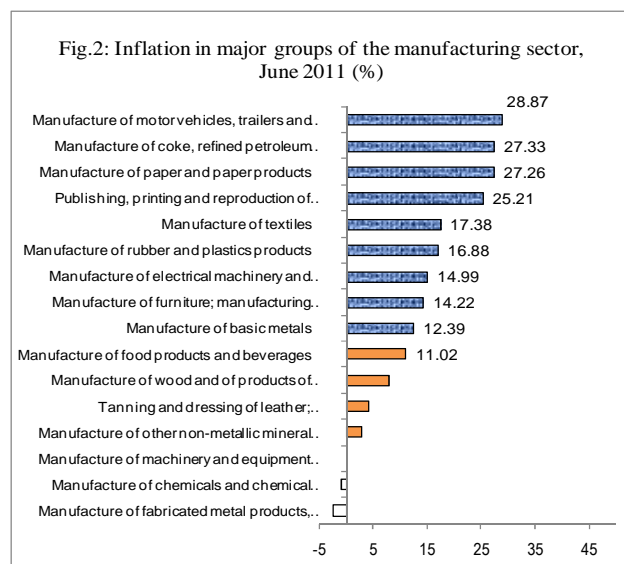
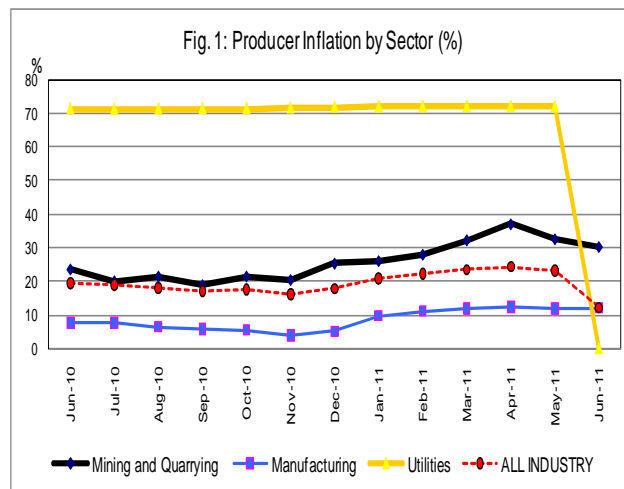
Inflation in this industry stabilized for the first two months of 2010, but dropped between March and June 2010. The rate declined in November 2010 after increasing slightly in October 2010. In January 2011 inflation in the petroleum industry jumped, but has remained stable, recording 27.33% in June 2011 (Fig 3).

Overview

The year-on-year producer inflation for all industry in June 2011 is 12.15%; the monthly rate is 0.47%.

Mining and quarrying recorded the highest rate of (30.24%), followed by manufacturing (12.10%). utilities recorded the lowest rate of 0.27%

Mining and quarrying recorded the highest monthly change of 1.18%, followed by manufacturing (0.42%); and utilities (0.01)

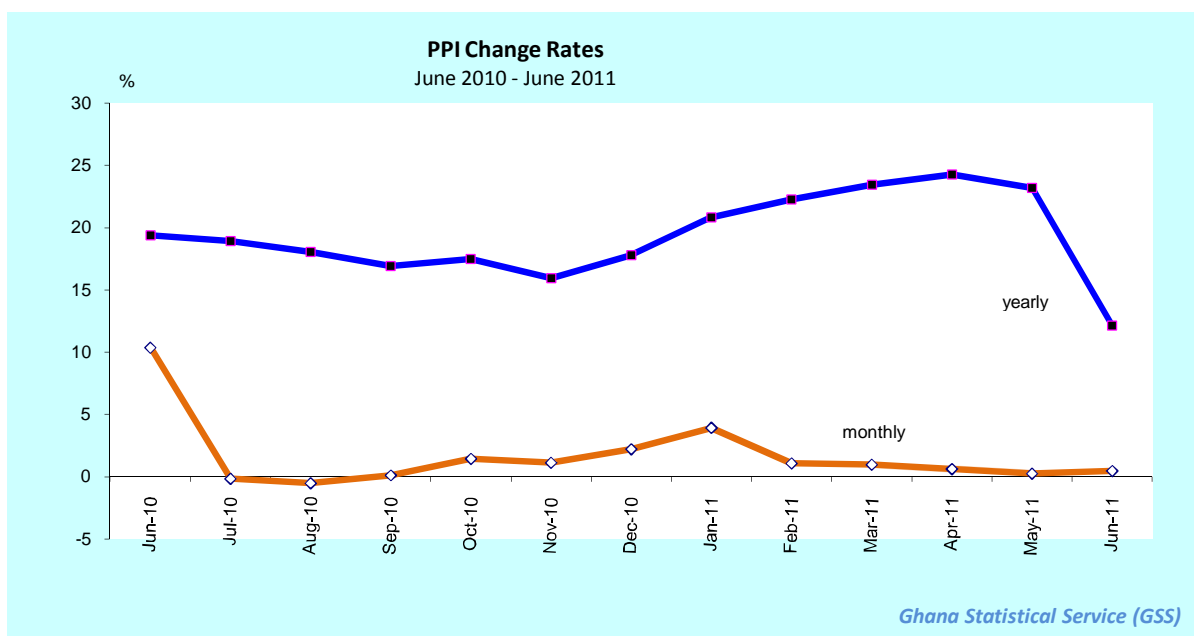
