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## Producer Price Inflation declines to 18.93 in July 2010.

### The Producer Price Index

The Producer Price Index (PPI) measures the average change over time in the prices received by domestic producers for the production of their goods and services. The PPI for Ghana reports the price indices with reference to September 2006, the base period. This release shows the producer price growth since September 2006, as well as the annual (point-to-point) and monthly inflation rates, for all industry and three major sub-sectors of industry (Mining and Quarrying, Manufacturing, and Utilities).

### July 2010 Producer Inflation

In July 2010 the Price Index with reference to the base period (September 2006) was 212.34, after recording 212.65 in June 2010. This translates to a monthly change rate (i.e., the percentage change in the PPI between June 2010 and July 2010) of **-0.14** percent, after 10.38 percent in June 2010 (Table 1).

The respective yearly change (i.e., the percentage change in the PPI between July 2010 and July 2009) was **18.93** percent, indicating a 0.46 percentage points lower than that for June 2010 (Table 1).

Manufacturing, the largest industrial sub-sector (with 69.75 percent share of all industry), recorded an inflation rate of 7.56 percent.

Mining and Quarrying (with 13.97 percent share of all industry) recorded inflation rate of 19.19 percent.

Utilities, (which includes production, transmission and distribution of electricity; collection, purification and distribution of water), recorded inflation rate of 71.09 percent.

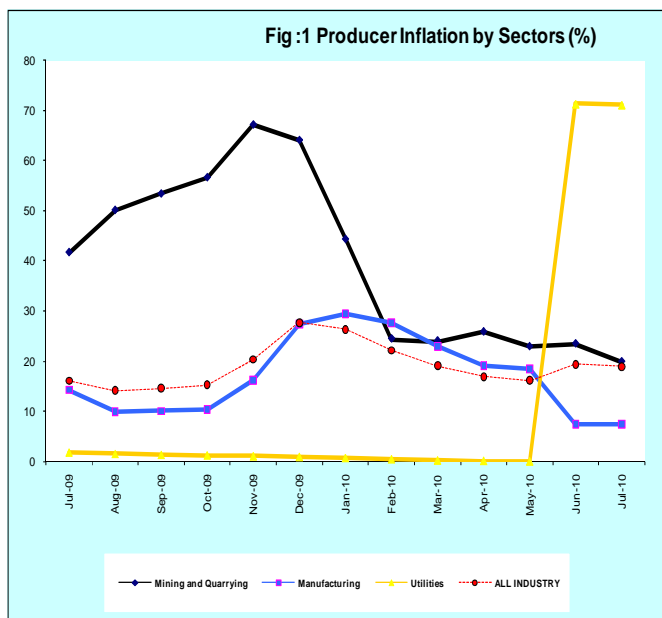
### Trends

Inflation for July 2010 was higher than the rate recorded in the same period in 2009 (16.09%). The all industry year-on-year average inflation for the first seven months of 2010 was 19.85 percent.

During the 13-month period (July 2009 to July 2010), the all industry recorded the highest inflation rate in December 2009 (27.71 percent). The rates,

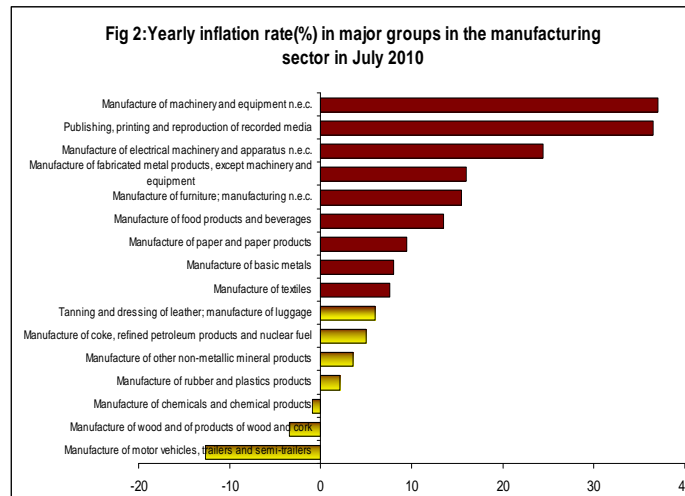
however, have been declining from January 2010 to May 2010, before it increased in June 2010.

Between July 2009 and May 2010, mining and quarrying sector exhibited the highest inflation rate, except in February 2010 when manufacturing recorded the highest. Utilities recorded the highest inflation in June and July 2010, (figure 1).



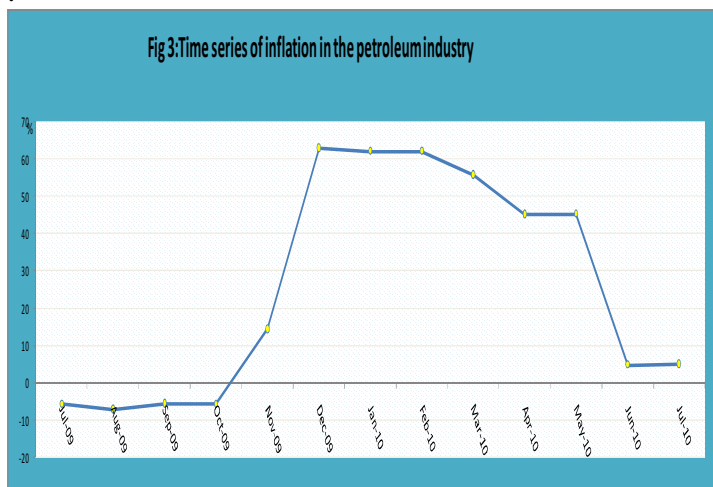
### Manufacturing Sector

Nine out of sixteen groups recorded inflation rates higher than the manufacturing sector average (figure 2). Manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c recorded the highest inflation rate (37.02%) while manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, manufacture of wood and of wood product and cork, and manufacture of chemical and chemical products recorded negative inflation rates of 12.65, 3.42 and 0.92 percent respectively.



### Petroleum Price Index

Between July 2009 and October 2009, producer inflation in the manufacture of petroleum products group recorded a negative rate. It however recorded a positive rate thereafter, with the highest rate for the last 12-month period being December 2009 (63.04%). The industry recorded a 2009 yearly average producer inflation of -6.67 percent. The rate for July 2010 was lower (0.14 percentage points) than that of June 2010 (fig 3).

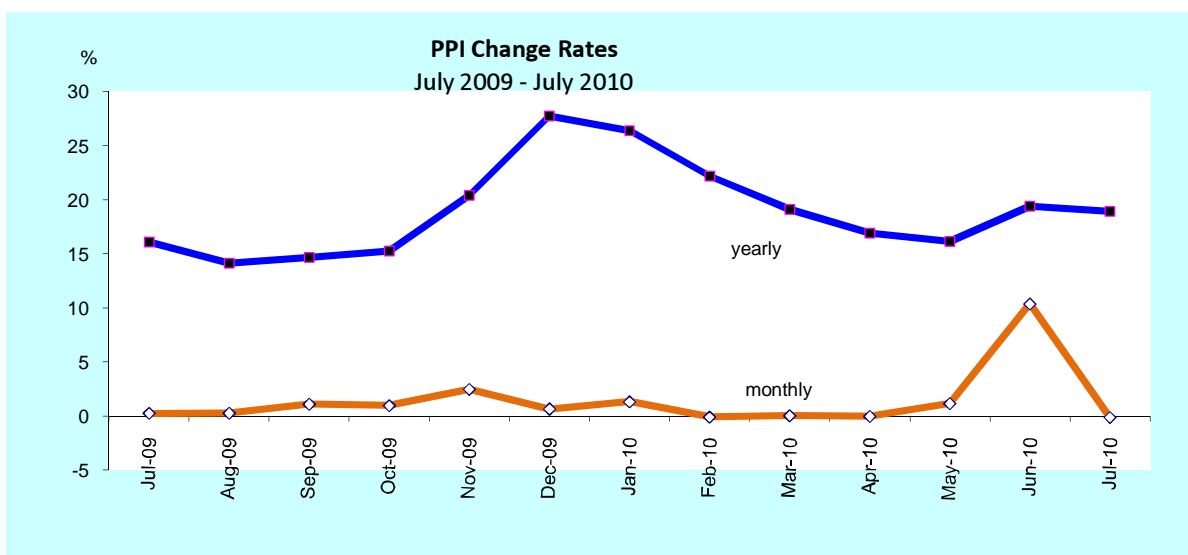
