

HIGHLIGHTS FOR JANUARY 2019

Inflation for January 2019 fell to 9.0%

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) measures the change over time in the general price level of goods and services that households acquire for the purpose of consumption, with reference to the price level in 2012, the base year, which has an index of 100.

The year-on-year inflation rate as measured by the CPI was 9.0 percent in January 2019 down by 0.4 percentage point from the 9.4 percent recorded in December 2018(Figure 1). This rate of inflation for January 2019 is the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the twelve-month period, from January 2018 to January 2019.



The monthly change rate for January 2019 was 1.0 percent compared with 1.1 percent recorded for December 2018.

Food and non-food inflation for January 2019

The Food and non-alcoholic beverages group recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of 8.0 percent. This is 0.7 percentage point lower than the 8.7 percent recorded in December 2018. Four subgroups of the food and non-alcoholic beverages group recorded inflation rates higher than the group's average rate of 8.0 percent. The subgroups were Coffee, tea and cocoa

(12.4%), Fruits (10.0%), Meat and meat products (9.8%) and Mineral water, soft drinks, fruit and vegetable juices (9.3%).

The non-food group recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of 9.5 percent in January 2019, compared to the rate of 9.8 percent recorded in December 2018. Five subgroups of the non-food group recorded year-on-year inflation rates higher than the group's average rate of 9.5 percent. Transport (13.4%), Clothing and footwear (12.8%), Recreation and Culture (12.7%), Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Maintenance (11.2%) and Miscellaneous goods and services (9.6%). Inflation was lowest in the Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Others Fuels subgroup (2.9%).

Regional differentials

At the regional level, the year-on-year inflation rate ranged from 7.7 percent in the Upper East Region to 10.8 percent in Upper West region. Four regions (Upper West, Brong Ahafo, Western and Ashanti) recorded inflation rates above the national average rate of 9.0 percent.

Year- on-year inflation by regions











Figure 7: Regional inflation rates (Year-on-year) - January 2019


