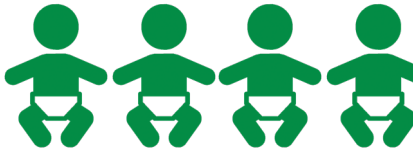

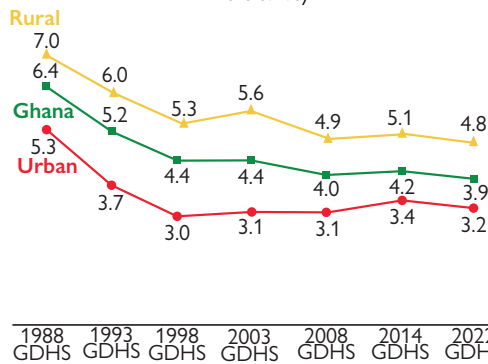
Fertility

More than **4 in 5** pregnant women age 15-49 had 4+ antenatal visits, as recommended.

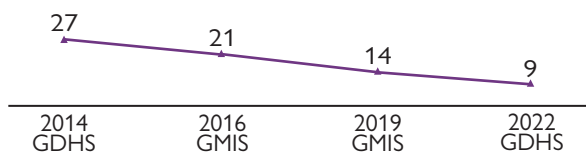


Over **4 in 5** live births were delivered in a health facility.

Trends Malaria Prevalence in Children

Percent of children 6-59 months testing positive for having malaria according to microscopy



40% of the Ghanaian household population slept under an ITN the night before the survey.

60% of pregnant women age 15-49 took the recommended 3+ doses of IPTp during pregnancy to prevent malaria.
