# **HIGHLIGHTS SEPTEMBER 2022**

## Inflation rate for SEPTEMBER 2022 is 37.2%

The Combined Consumer Price Index (CPI) measures the change over time in the general price level of goods and services that households acquire for the purpose of consumption, with reference to the price level in 2018, the base year, which has an index of 100.

The year-on-year inflation rate as measured by the CPI was **37.2** percent in September 2022 (Figure 1). This rate of inflation for September 2022 is the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the twelve-month period, from September 2021 to September 2022. The monthly change rate for September 2022 is **2.0** percent.




## Food and Non-food inflation for SEPTEMBER 2022

The Food and Non-alcoholic beverages inflation rate recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of **37.8 %** September for 2022.

The Non-Food group recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of **36.8 %** in September 2022.

## **Regional differentials**

At the regional level, the year-on-year inflation rate ranged from **41.0%** percent in Eastern Region to **22.9** percent in the Upper West Region. Three Regions has recorded inflation rate above the national average of **37.2%**.
