

HIGHLIGHTS OCTOBER 2022

Inflation rate for OCTOBER 2022 is 40.4%

The Combined Consumer Price Index (CPI) measures the change over time in the general price level of goods and services that households acquire for the purpose of consumption, with reference to the price level in 2018, the base year, which has an index of 100.

The year-on-year inflation rate as measured by the CPI was **40.4** percent in October 2022 (Figure 1). This rate of inflation for October 2022 is the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the twelve-month period, from October 2021 to October 2022. The monthly change rate for October 2022 is **2.7** percent.



Food and Non-food inflation for OCTOBER 2022

The Food and Non-alcoholic beverages inflation rate recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of **43.7** % September for 2022.

The Non-Food group recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of 37.8 % in October 2022.

Regional differentials

At the regional level, the year-on-year inflation rate ranged from **51.1** percent in Eastern Region to **25.8** percent in the Volta Region. Six Regions has recorded inflation rate above the national average of **40.4%**.









Figure 7: Regional Inflation rates (Year-on-year) - October 2022


