

HIGHLIGHTS FEBRUARY 2021- New Series

Inflation rate for February 2021 is 10.3%

The Combined Consumer Price Index (CPI) measures the change over time in the general price level of goods and services that households acquire for the purpose of consumption, with reference to the price level in 2018, the base year, which has an index of 100.

The year-on-year inflation rate as measured by the CPI was **10.3** percent in February 2021, which is 0.4 percentage points higher than January 2020 (Figure 1). This rate of inflation for February 2021 is the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the twelve-month period, from February 2020 to February 2021. The monthly change rate for February 2021 is 0.8 percent.




Food and Non-food inflation for February 2021

The Food and Non–alcoholic beverages recorded a year–on–year inflation rate of **12.3** % for February 2021.

The Non-Food group recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of **8.8** percent in February 2021.

Regional differentials


At the regional level, the year-on-year inflation rate ranged from **4.4** percent in the Volta Region to **14.8** percent in the Greater Accra Region. All the regions except Ashanti regions recorded inflation rates below the national average of **10.3**%.






